Silverwood May Ride Silver Phantom

SYDNEY, Monday. Trainer Jack Green will sail with jockey Neville Sellwood returning from America before engaging a jockey for Silver Phantom in the Flying Han cheap at Canterbury on Saturday.

Green said he would offer Sellwood the mount.

Silverwood and trainer Maurice McCarty will arrive back from the United States later this week.

Silver Phantom and Carice were coupled for an estimate-5000 in the Doncaster-Sydney Cup double today.

Silver Phantom is second favourite for the cup, with Carice an equal favourite with New Zealand Gold Scheme.

In another huge plunge, Electra, second to Prince Mervil in the A.I.C. Derby, and Newmar for Carlough Plate winner, Birdwood, 9-4, coupled for £30,000. Star New Zealand stayer, Mt Denby, was also bracketed with Birdwood for £10,000.

Dual Derby winner, Prince Mervil, is an unlikely starter in the St. Lager and Cup, trained by E. J. Fellows said today.

Last week the colt struck him self during exercise.

Fellows said today there was still some soreness in the leg and he would give the horse a week's rest.

MUNRO'S TACTICS MADE SURE OF ALDERSHOT'S CARBINE STAKES VICTORY

MELBOURNE, Monday. Darby Munro received a great reception from the crowd at Flemington today when he rode a splendid race on Aldershot in the weight-for-age Carbine Stakes to beat Wodalla by three-quarters of a length.

Prince O'Fairies, the only other starter, was 20 lengths away third.

The race was run at a slow pace for the first half mile or so with Munro on Aldershot in the lead, but not anxious to pass.

Purtell on Wodalla did not pass for the slow pace and soon jared Aldershot. From then the pace was much quicker.

Wodalla continued to lead until well into the straight, when Munro got to work on Aldershot and with 100 yards to go, cut down Wodalla to win going away.

Aldershot as an even money favourite.

Undoubtedly Munro was the master tactician of the race, but it is difficult to see what else Purtell could have done. If he had permitted Aldershot to set a slow pace Aldershot would still have won, as he could out-sprint Wodalla in a dash home.

Munro's vigour on Aldershot was something out of the ordinary. He went Aldershot after Wodalla in a style that earned him the nickname "Demon."

It was a hard race and Munro was in a state of near collapse when he was dismounted. He was assisted to the ground by Mr. Alan Bell, chief stipendiary steward.

Trainer Fined £50 For Battery Accusation

BRISBANE, Monday. Queensland Turf Club stewards today fined Toowoomba trainer, Dick Dempster, £50 for allegedly accusing jockey Alf Sanders of having used a battery.

Last Tuesday at the Clifford Park track Dempster allegedly accused Sanders of using a battery on the filly Navleigh, when she won the Doomben Juvenile Handicap on February 27.

Sanders, in evidence, said Dempster had said to him "How's the battery?" as he walked past him at the Clifford Park track last Tuesday morning.

Sanders said he asked, "What battery?" and Dempster said "The battery you used on Navleigh when she beat my filly (Highland Plains) on Saturday."

Dempster then ran his hands over Sanders' pockets.

Dempster told the stewards that he had put his hands into Sanders' pocket after the jockey had said, "Search me."

Dempster denied that he had referred to Navleigh.

LAST -- SECOND BENDIGO THOUSAND WIN TO BROWN

BENDIGO, Monday. In a sensational last-second burst, 47-year-old commercial traveller, Fred Brown, of Windor, narrowly won the classical 1954 Bendigo Thousand from the odds-on favourite, Reg Gough, of Essendon.

Gough, of 11 yards, led until a few feet from the tape when Brown, off 101 yards, made a powerful throw to win by inches.

Brown's time of 11.7 for the 130 yards was one-tenth of a second slower than the record set by Dave Hobbs in 1922.

In third place was Henry McIntyre, of Alphington, followed by Doug Gardiner, of West Colong, and P. Nicholls, of Brunswick.

Starting at 4/1 against Brown upset the experts' calculations. Three of the field were "anced ahead of him.

Brown has been training under former runner, Ted Marantelli, at Royal Park.

Carruthers Trains For Sinn Bout

SYDNEY, Monday. World bantam champion, Jimmy Carruthers, began training today for his fight with Australian champion, Bobby Sinn at Sydney Stadium on March 29.

Leading amateurs Bert O'Keefe and Teddy Stone will give Carruthers fast workouts.

Trainer Bill McConnell said today "Jimmy's speed is his best fight weapon, and O'Keefe and Stone are two of the fastest boxers in my gym."

Carruthers' manager, Dr. John McGill, said he would need an assurance that English promoters had engaged No. 1 contender, Frenchman Robert Colson before he allowed his boxer to go to England.
